We just met with Deputy Steinberg to prepare him for his participation in the Arctic Council Meeting of Deputy Ministers, which begins in Copenhagen Wednesday evening.

Part of the discussions in Copenhagen relates to the Arctic Council task force on Short-Lived Carbon Forcers, and the deputy ministers will, we hope, praise the on-going work and ask that it be continued as a matter of priority. (The SLCF TF was a US idea, agreed at the Council ministerial a year ago, and EPA leads the effort.) In this context, D(S) said he would like to receive "from Todd" input on where we are on the Cancun Process as it may affect any Arctic-related climate issues. He's interested in the "intersection" between current climate policy and the Arctic.

D staff asked me to pass on this request. Lourdes may have some thoughts on what sort of information is needed and in what form.
